

The Alabama State Council on the Arts Seeks a Visual Arts Program Manager



The Alabama State Council on the Arts is a state agency based in Montgomery and serving all of Alabama. The Mission of the Alabama State Council on the Arts is to enhance the quality of life and economic vitality for all Alabamians by providing support for the state's diverse and rich artistic resources. The Council was established in 1967 and employs seventeen professional staff members. ASCA operates with a state appropriation of over five-million dollars plus \$765,000 in federal funds provided by the NEA. Over 330 grants to 225-plus organizations, schools and individual artists are awarded and administered annually.

The Visual Arts Program Manager is responsible for an annual grant program budget of \$600,000+ and manages all aspects of the Georgine Clarke Alabama Artist Gallery, which hosts 6-8 exhibitions annually. The VAPM works with visual and craft artists, small and large arts organizations, and museums throughout the state.

Minimum Requirements

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university in a visual arts medium, art history, media arts, art education, aesthetics, art criticism, humanities, arts administration, museum studies, or a closely related field.
- Three years of experience developing and managing visual arts programs for a college/university arts facility, art museum, arts center, for-profit or non-profit art gallery, local art organization, a city, county, state, or federal entity, or similar organization.
- *A Master's degree from an accredited college or university in one of the fields listed above may substitute for one year of the required experience.

*The Council is now accepting applications.
The application deadline is **August 1, 2018.***
